#### **PS29** lice policy reminder:

- 3 or more cases of lice/nits per class >> lice outbreak protocol is implemented
  - Separation/isolation of outerwear
  - Periodic lice checks by the nurse and trained staff
  - Deep cleaning by PS29 custodial staff

## Accessibility Project

#### NY SCA representative Danielle Schaaf to address questions from PS29 parents:

#### 1. Construction Site Security

- How will contractors and construction workers be supervised during the project? Are there protocols in place to ensure they adhere to school safety policies while on-site?
- How will access to the construction site be controlled? Will there be designated entry points for workers?

#### 2. Health and Safety Protocols During Construction

- Will the construction cause any disruption to the school's indoor air circulation or HVAC system? If so, how will air quality be maintained and monitored inside the school building?
- What steps will be taken to minimize dust and airborne particles during construction, and what protocols will be in place to monitor air quality? How can we be sure the monitoring is sufficient and that the air is safe? Will data be available to share? How will you ensure parents that this is being taken seriously and that no hazardous materials are being overlooked?
- Will any chemicals (e.g., paints, adhesives, cleaning agents) be used during construction that could pose a health risk? How will the school ensure that these chemicals are safely stored and ventilated?
- Will any construction activities impact the school's water supply or plumbing? How will the school ensure that drinking water and water for handwashing remain safe throughout the project?
- Will there be any protocols in place to monitor the health of students and staff during the construction, especially in cases where students have pre-existing conditions that might be exacerbated by environmental changes?
- How will the construction crew handle safety concerns during inclement weather (e.g., storms, heavy rain)? Will there be additional precautions in place for student safety during such times?



## PS29+ Afterschool Program Enrollment

- Enrollment at PS29+ continues to grow! Average number of kids in courses and Kid's Club grew from 305 last winter to 340 this winter, an increase of just over 10%!
- Of 715 students at PS29, 543 students (76%) use are enrolled in courses or Kid's Club plus many use the Emergency Kid's Club.


